4 March A Personal Choice Music chosen by Alan Spooner.

18 March Strangers in America Pieces by a few of the many composers who found a new home in the United States. Introduced by David Clark.

1 April Your Hundred (or maybe 20) Best Tunes Selected by Robin Stocker.

15 April Favourite Performers (3) Bill Cooper introduces recordings by a favourite singer, pianist, violinist and conductor, following two previous such programmes in 2019.
