For those who are not familiar with Bletchley Park – It was the Centre for all code – breaking operations during World War II and was made famous by the supreme effort of Alan Turing and his Team who ultimately cracked the secrets of the German 'ENIGMA' Machine that was an important element of our victory in Europe during 1939-1945.

This was done by building the FIRST Electronic Digital Computer that enabled vast amounts of data to be processed and complex calculations to be made much faster than any human being.

The Cost of this trip is **£26-00 per person** and includes Return Coach Fare and Entrance charge at Bletchley Park. It also includes a Multimedia Guide that is offered to all visitors, **(subject to availability)**. These handy devices are basically an iPod Touch loaded with informative and entertaining stories, anecdotes and activities to further enhance the visitor experience. They are free of charge.

These Multimedia Guides bring the visitor's experience of enjoying Bletchley Park firmly into the twenty-first century. The handheld player is easy to use and allows people to explore the Home of the Codebreakers informatively, at their own pace and in their own time.
